Marsden to Seek Council Seat

Citing a need for fiscal responsibility and increased engagement with citizens, Marsden will bring forth recommendations to

- Enhance fiscal responsibility – targeting a zero percent property tax increase and a cap on council salaries
- Engage the community through citizen led committees and term limits for elected officials
- Create Employment opportunities – attracting new businesses with good paying jobs to help aide in our goal for affordable living.

Currently a member of the Board of the BC Chamber of Commerce and a past President of the Tri Cities Chamber, and Treasurer of the Eagle Ridge Hospital Foundation, Marsden has worked with Senior levels of government to address the needs of residents on topics from the property transfer tax and utilization of the Riverview lands for the delivery of mental Health services. He cites these experiences as ones that can best prepare him to help build solutions with residents and staff for the challenges that we face on a daily basis.
